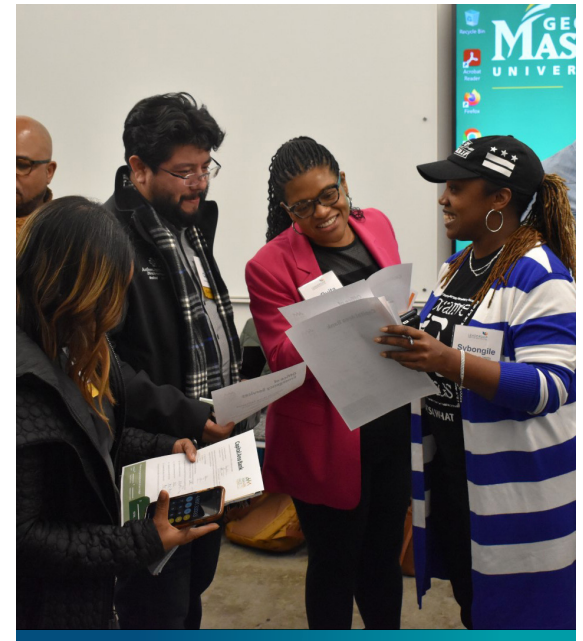


SIGNATURE PROGRAM

Since 1986, Leadership Greater Washington (LGW) has developed over 2,000 executive leaders from DC, Northern Virginia, and Suburban Maryland through its flagship offering, the Signature Program — an intensive 10-month program that dives into the critical issues impacting the Greater Washington region with a focus on awareness, systems thinking, and civic action to foster inclusive regional growth.

Program participation each year is limited to a cohort of 50-60 experienced leaders from the private, nonprofit, and public sectors. We give these leaders the structure and space to learn from each other - nurturing growth with authenticity, trust, and deep respect. In doing so, we weave widely diverse perspectives into the tightly knit relationships that drive change and community progress.
